### History

The 10 Commandments are a special set of rules given by God to a man named Moses in the Old Testament. They were designed to help people love God and be kind, fair, and respectful to everyone around them.

Jesus said the Ten Commandments can all be summed up into two simple rules: **Love God** and **Love your 'neighbour'**.

Some Christians will choose to be 'confirmed' or 'baptised' to make a public commitment that they want to follow the teachings of Jesus Christ.

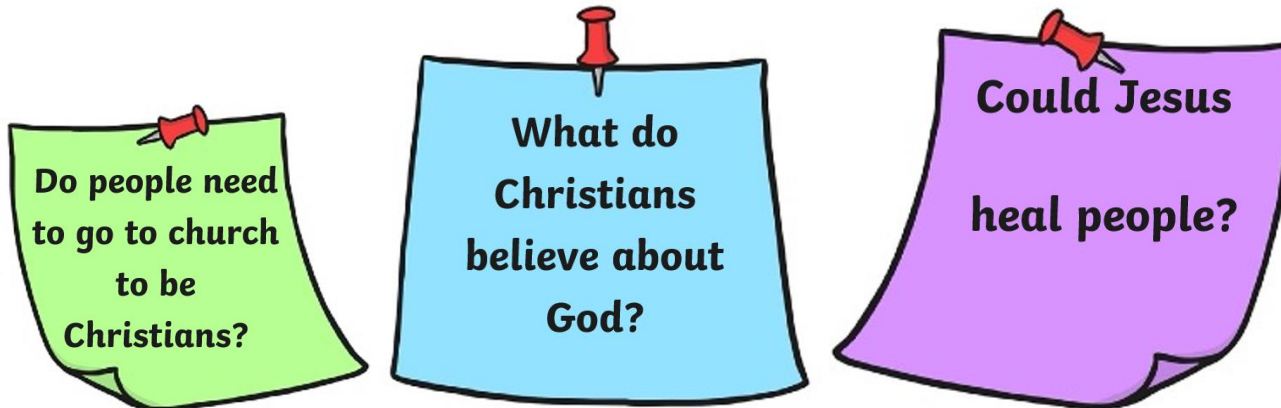
### Key Information

<b>10 Commandments</b>	Rules given to Moses in the desert when he led the Israelites out of Egypt.
<b>Gifts of the Holy Spirit</b>	Special strength given to Christians to help them serve God. For example: the gift of encouragement or wisdom.
<b>Prayer</b>	Talking to God to share your feelings, say thank you or ask questions.
<b>The Lord's Prayer</b>	A famous prayer that Jesus taught his friends (called his disciples) when they asked him how to talk to God.

Christians believe that everyone is their 'neighbour' so they will try treat other people in the way they would like to be treated.

Many Christians will regularly attend church to publicly demonstrate their commitment to God and their faith.
