**Churchill** is a village and parish in the district of North Somerset, part of the historical county of Somerset. It is located on the western edge of the Mendip Hills, about 8 miles east of Weston Super Mare, and about 15 miles south-west of Bristol. The parish, which includes the village of **Lower Langford** and the hamlet of **Upper Langford**, has a population of 2,250.
