Year 6 visit to Life skills – 11th February 2025

We are delighted to confirm that Year 6 will be visiting the Create Centre for a 'Life skills' workshop on Tuesday 11th February 2025 as part of our PHSE curriculum. Life skills is an interactive safety education centre, built as a realistic village, which has been developed to teach children how to deal with potentially difficult or dangerous situations, whilst in a safe environment. The children are fully supervised throughout their visit and, in previous years, have gained valuable life lessons, vital to them continuing to build their independence ahead of transition to secondary school.

IMPORTANT- if your child has been involved in any trauma such as a fire or a car accident, please can you speak directly to a Year 6 staff member in advance of the trip, as these are scenarios that will be discussed.

Due to the timings, all children will need to have a packed lunch to eat in school on our return, (these can be ordered via school meals if required). Children should arrive at school for registration, promptly at **08.30am** and will need to be wearing school uniform with a coat.

The total cost for this exciting and valuable activity is £19 per child, inclusive of coach costs. Please complete the information and submit payment, via ParentPay, by Friday 24th January. We are sure that you appreciate we are dependent on contributions to make trips possible. As always, if we have insufficient funds coming in, the trip may not be able to go ahead.
