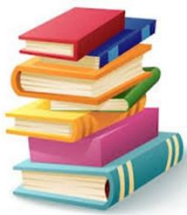
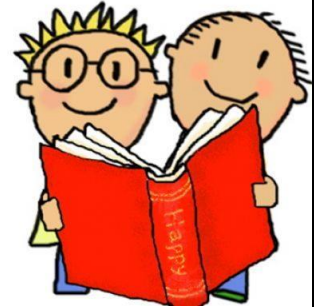




Year R Homework Expectations

Reading

In Reception, the most important thing you can do to help your child to make good progress is to hear him/her read... every day if possible. Your child will bring home a variety of books to share with you. Don't forget to read to your child too; the best readers and writers are children who have a wide experience of books and stories.

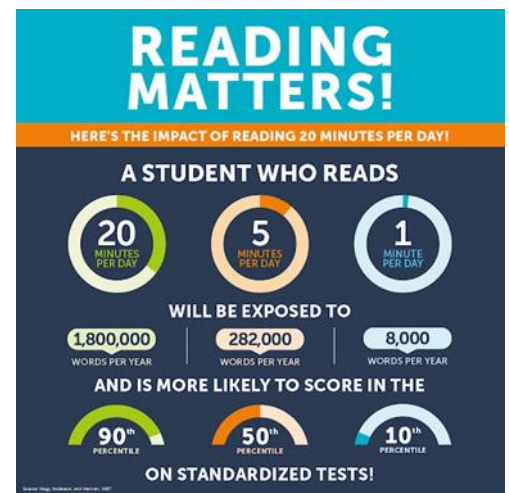

We expect children to read **at least 5 times a week**.

Books will be changed **when they have been read at home 3 times**. Please record what they have read in their reading record book. The YR team regularly listen to your child read to establish if more support/extension is needed.

Your child will also bring a library book home for you to share together (which will most probably be one they are not able to read independently). The library books will be changed once a week on a Friday.



Phonics
