Communication and Language

Take part in discussions with relevant comments, questions and experiences.

Retell a story using a story map. Explore and expand our vocabulary.



Personal, Social and Emotional Development

Identify things we are good at and understand that everyone is good at different things. How can we be good friends? Continue to explore our feelings and relate them to the 4 Zones of Regulation.



Physical Development

Explore drawing, writing and copying using correct sitting position, pen grip and pressure to show increasing control. Move with control in a space and explore travelling around, over and under apparatus.



Literacy

Continue to learn new phonemes to blend and segment in order to read and write vc and cvc words. Handwriting - form our letters correctly.



Mathematics

Subitise, represent, compare and compose numbers 1-5 using 5 frames, 10 frames, fingers, numerals and objects. Explore spatial reasoning using 2D shapes and shape puzzles



Understanding the World

Who are the people in the community who help us? Important places, maps, jobs, stranger and safer stranger, road safety.

Christmas – giving, saying thank you and 'The Christmas Story'.

What is the difference between light and dark? Understand what light is, sources of light and darkness as the opposite. How are shadows created?
